## **Babyshoes**

**Knitting Needles** size 3,5 used and yarn that fits the size.

If you use smaller needles and yarn, you have to cast on more stitches and knit more rows to get the size you want.

### Cast on:

Cast on 36 stitches / 9 stitched per needle and join them in the round.

Knit the following repeatedly for **25 rows: 2 knit 2 purl.** 

### Knit 1 row.

After that you will need one row with holes, if you want to add a ribbon. **Knit two together, yarn over**, repeatedly for one row.

#### Knit 1 row.

Now you will start to form the shoe itself.

Only on **needle 1**: knit in seed stitch for 18 rows. (1knit, 1purl)

# Pick up the stitched at the sides of the seed stitch flap with needle 2 and 4.

Knit in garter stitch on **all 4 needles** for 9 rows starting and ending with a purl row.

After that you just have to close the **sole** of the shoe by knitting in garter stitch on **needle 1**. At the end of each row knit the last stitch together with one stitch of needle 2 and 4. When only the stitches on needle 1 and 3 are left **cast** them **off** together.

The shoe is done! Now you only have to weave in the ends and put a ribbon through the holes. Have fun!
